

**SUBJECT: LIMITED EXEMPTION OF HOURS OF SERVICE FOR CARRIERS
TRANSPORTING EMERGENCY RELIEF SUPPLIES**

Based on the impacts anticipated to affect the Commonwealth as a result of Hurricane Florence, beginning September 8, 2018, the Governor has declared a State of Emergency seeking relief for all carriers transporting essential relief supplies to, through, and from any area of the Commonwealth.

These exceptions activate the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, Section 390.23 Relief of Regulations, including hours of service, and are granted for the period beginning 11 a.m. September 10, 2018, until 5 p.m. October 10, 2018, or whenever the crisis has abated, whichever is sooner.

This information is for immediate dissemination to preclude inadvertent ticketing or detention. Multi-agency support and cooperation is appreciated. If there are any questions, please contact the Virginia Emergency Support Team Coordinator at (804) 674-2400.
